A computer controlled Lutron lighting system provides every lighting configuration from near daylight conditions to total darkness. All at the simple touch of a button.

Our PA and audio-visual systems are completely integrated and linked to roving wireless microphones, while an induction loop antenna ensures hearing impaired delegates have no problem following proceedings.

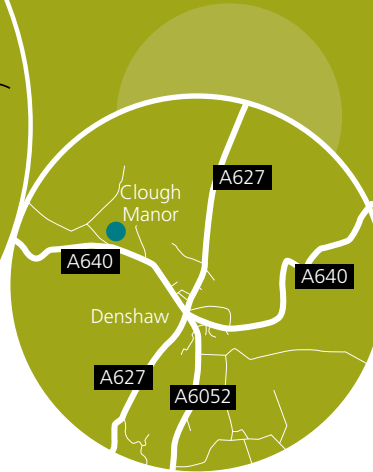

How to find us

Although it stands in some of the most beautiful and unspoilt countryside in the north of England, Clough Manor is easily reached wherever your guests are coming from and however they're travelling.

By road

From the south exit at Junction 21 M62. Follow the A640 towards Denshaw. From the north exit at Junction 22 M62. Follow A672 towards Oldham and turn right onto the A640 at the Denshaw crossroads.

By train

Newhey station	1.8 miles
Milnrow station	2.6 miles
Greenfield station	4.4 miles

By air

Manchester Airport	24 miles
Leeds Bradford Airport	30 miles
